The following form must be read and signed by you and your child.

- I will limit my use of all telecommunications systems in school to the educational objectives approved by my teachers and/or school staff.
- I will communicate only for educational purposes and only through the official network address and email addresses issued to me.
- I will follow the rules on network etiquette.
- I will not retrieve or send unethical, illegal, immoral, inappropriate or unacceptable information of any type nor will I use abusive language of any type.
- I will not share my full name, home address or telephone number with another user for any purpose.
- I understand that information received on-line is private property, unless specified. I will not plagiarize information received in any form. I will adhere to all copyright laws.
- I will not use another person's account or share my password with anyone else.
- I will not attempt to bypass the security built into the system, to gain access to any remote site through the process of "hacking", or to install unapproved software or executable files and I recognize that doing so will result in the immediate termination of my telecommunications privileges.
- I will not interfere with or disrupt network users, services or equipment.
- I will not access chat rooms without direct supervision by a teacher. I understand this may be banned by my district or by my school.
- I will not use the Internet or other telecommunications systems to buy and/or sell any items, goods or services of any kind for personal gain.
- I will use the Internet or other telecommunications systems only with active or direct supervision by a teacher and/or school staff.

Morgan County Schools will not be held responsible if the student participates in any of the aforementioned banned activities.

We have read the aforesaid consent and waiver for the use of Internet and/or other telecommunication systems in the classroom. We understand that this access is for only educational purposes; that any infraction will terminate user privileges and may result in further disciplinary action, including suspension from school.

We further agree to abide by the rules contained within State Policy 2460, County Policy and school policy on Internet/Telecommunication whenever using District resources.

CHILD FIND ACTIVITIES

Morgan County Schools provides a free appropriate public education to all eligible special education students. Referrals can be made to the School Assistance Team (SAT) at the child's school. The purpose of the SAT is to assist teachers and parents in helping students who are having difficulties in the regular education program. Each SAT is responsible for developing a plan to assist students and for monitoring their progress for at least one grading period. If you have any questions or require more information, please contact the principal at your child's school.

Children ages 3-21 not enrolled in a Morgan County Public School can be referred directly to the Office of Special Education at 247 Harrison Ave, Berkeley Springs, WV 25411 (304-258-2430 x22). Children under the age of three can be referred to WV Birth to Three services at RESA 8 304-267-3595.

Morgan County Schools also conducts child-find activities. Students entering Morgan County Schools will participate in developmental screening for vision, hearing, speech, and language. Special Education Procedural Safeguards will be provided annually to parents of eligible children and adult students prior to the annual IEP review or upon request for evaluations. The safeguards can also be found on-line at the Morgan County website under the special education department section. Upon request to the Morgan County Special Education Office, a paper copy will be sent.

SUPPORT FOR PERSONALIZED LEARNING

When you suspect your child may be experiencing difficulties or boredom in academic achievement and/or developmental processes, you should contact the child's teacher to arrange a conference to discuss ideas and strategies that may help your child in the learning process.

Your concerns may be addressed through Support for Personalized Learning (SPL), if your child is in school. In West Virginia, SPL is a process in which a child may receive targeted or more intensive instruction when progress in general education, such as in reading, mathematics, or behavior is not at the level expected as determined by screenings and information collected by teachers. Parents will be informed of the SPL process, including strategies used to help the child learn and progress data that will be collected. If, after a period of time, the data show the child may need special education and related services, school personnel may refer the child for a multi-disciplinary evaluation.

At any time during the SPL process, you have the right to request an evaluation for special education, if you believe this is what your child needs. This request should be made in writing to the Student Assistance Team (SAT) at the school. The SAT has ten days to decide whether the evaluation will be conducted and provide you written notice of its decision.
